The 24" x 20" face gives you plenty of room for long range, all-season shooting. Surprisingly light, at just 12 lbs., the large Black Hole is very portable as well. Vertical layers make it ideal for shooting from your tree stand.

Features:

1) Open-layer design:

This revolutionary technology, which eliminates the need for the target to stop arrows with brute force, allows for a lighter weight target, a longer lasting target and easier arrow removal.

2) Lightweight and portable:

Black Hole targets are extremely lightweight which makes them easy to move around in the backyard, easy to take with you on a hunt and easy to store when not in use.

3) Takes field tips, broadheads and expandables:

Because the Black Hole stops arrows by squeezing the shaft as it slides between layers, the target is able to take field tips, broadheads and expandables. 4) Vertical layers for shooting from above:

Other layered targets use horizontal layers which work just fine until you want to practice from a tree stand. That's why you want to use vertical layers. When shot from above, the arrows still slide between layers instead of puncturing down through. The result is a target that lasts longer and gives you more shooting options.

5) Super-easy arrow removal:

There is nothing worse than struggling to remove arrows from a target. Thanks to the open layer design, Black Hole targets offer super-easy arrow removal. And, when the arrow removal is easy, you'll practice more!
